

SUPPLIES LIST FOR DRAWING FOR ABSOLUTE BEGINNERS

Estimated cost of supplies: \$25 - \$40

1. Four graphite drawing pencils: H, 2B, 4B, 6B (and any other pencils the student wishes to bring along, such as those that come in a set)
2. Pocket-size or battery powered pencil sharpener
3. 14" x 17" or larger pad of white drawing paper. No newsprint.
6. Two kinds of erasers: a) a white plastic eraser (Recommended: Staedtler Mars) and b) a kneaded eraser (Recommended: Design brand). No Pink Pearl.
7. Medium size ("cigar" size) paper "stump" for blending and smudging
8. 18" T-square
9. A can of fixative to keep your drawings from smudging
